This letter is a Fixed Penalty Formal Warning and is being sent to you because you requested a period of absence from school for your child during term time.

The period you requested from _____ to _____, was not deemed to be exceptional circumstances and therefore was coded as unauthorised absence. This letter is being sent as a warning that should you remove your child from school again without authorisation, a Fixed Penalty Notice may be issued. This warning is valid for two years.

A Fixed Penalty Notice is a strategy used by schools to address the unacceptable levels of attendance of children attending their school under the following legal framework:

- **Section 7 of the Education Act 1996 places upon parents a duty to ensure that their child receives efficient full-time education either by regular attendance at school or otherwise**
- **Where a child is a registered pupil at a school and the parent fails to ensure that child's regular attendance at school the parent is liable to be prosecuted for a criminal offence under Section 444 of the Education Act**
- **In cases where this duty is not being fulfilled Section 444B of the same Act empowers the Local Authority to issue a Fixed Penalty of either £60.00 or £120.00.**
