## **CURRENT YEAR 3 RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO FRONTIER CENTRE – APRIL 2019**

Thank you very much for the feedback we received from our recent survey regarding a residential for the Year 4 pupils.

The feedback was very positive in terms of the school providing a residential, with many of you stating what a benefit it was for siblings who have previously been on residentials at this age, and how confidence increased and special memories were made. The feedback on the cost and length of the trip were also considered. This has helped us make the following decision.

We have booked the following: Frontier Centre, Irthlingborough, Northamptonshire NN9 5UH, for 2 nights from 1<sup>st</sup>- 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2019. Frontier Centre is run by Rock UK, and the details can be found at <https://rockuk.org/centres/frontier-centre/> Please take a look at the website with your son / daughter to see how exciting it looks.

The cost of this residential will be £140 including transport and all activities. Therefore we are requesting an initial non-refundable deposit of £30 to be paid by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> May. At this stage we will confirm our numbers to Frontier Centre.

After receipt of the deposit, we will implement a payment plan and payments can be made regularly to fit with your family budgeting and spread over the 11 months before the visit takes place. Full payment will be required by the beginning of March 2019.

We wish to support parents eligible for free school meals – i.e. those in receipt of Income Support, Income Based Job Seekers Allowance or Child Tax Credit with an annual income of less than £16,190 (NB this does not include those receiving working tax credit).
