The Golden Boot Challenge!

Dear Parents

As part of our initiative to create a healthier environment through sustainable travel, Baston School will be taking part in its third Golden Boot Challenge from Monday 25th to Friday 29th September 2017.

For one week only, the children will be asked to walk/cycle or scoot to school rather than travel by car. Every day, at the double gates, the entrance to the drive, each child will be presented with a special 'Golden Boot' token to show that he/she has completed the task. This token should then be handed in to the class teacher during registration. Totals from each class will be taken on a daily basis and compared to the rest of the school. The winning class will be awarded a lovely, big, shiny Golden Boot Trophy at the end of the week - so please do make a special effort to take part!

As a special incentive, there will be a 'spot prize' given out at random to one child every day. The spot prize token is going to be 'hidden' amongst the Golden Boot tokens to make the chance of winning it fair for all. This spot prize token can be handed in to Mrs Mills and exchanged for a prize. Good luck!

We are also conscious that some children do not live in the village and therefore cannot be expected to walk/scoot or bike to school. For those children we will be providing a 'walking bus' which will set off from The Barn in Baston at 8.20am with members of staff. Parents can drop their child/ren off at The Barn shortly before the above-mentioned time and are encouraged to walk to school with them if at all possible. **We will be leaving promptly each day.**

There will also be a special 'Activ8 walking bus' for those children who are pre-booked into any of the morning sessions. A letter advising of all the details will be sent separately to those parents.

We really hope that all parents will enter into the spirit of this initiative and support their children in their healthy journey to school.

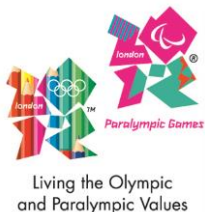
