## **HOMEWORK**

We have tried to design homework based on the preferences of parents. We now ask that you support your child to complete the tasks that he/she has been set.

At EYFS & KS1 level it is expected that all children will sign on to Education City at least once a week in order to complete the maths activity that has been set by the teacher. Each week the activity changes to compliment the maths topic that is being covered in class. Therefore your child is required to complete the activity between Monday and Friday of that week.

Reading Eggs is an ongoing homework which can be logged into at any time. This is a progressive homework that moves at the rate of your child's success. The more activities your child completes, the more eggs your child earns. Reading Eggs supports your child's phonic and reading skills and is therefore an important supplement to your child's day to day English lesson.

Passwords for both homework sites can be found on the inside cover of your child's homework book (this used to be the 'My Choice' book).

Your child will also be given a set of words to learn and write in EYFS or spellings in KS1. These will be stuck into the old 'My Choice' books in the first week of term when it is expected that parents will take responsibility for helping their child to learn how to spell these words ready for a test in the last week of term. It is essential that homework books are brought back into school in the last week of term so that new spellings can be given and stored inside.

At Baston CE Primary School we continue to aim for high standards in reading, writing and mathematics and it is only through obtaining a joint partnership with parents and teachers that this can be achieved. Please ensure that your child completes his/her homework every week.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all children and families who are taking the time and making the effort to diligently complete homework every week. We know who you are and your efforts do not go unnoticed.
