

## Baston CE Primary School - returning to school on June 1st

### Frequently Asked Questions



#### **How will social distancing work in the classroom?**

We have allowed a 2m separation between desks and 1.5m separation on the floor for carpet spaces for our youngest children. This is why some of our groups are below the 15 recommended. Some year groups have been split into more than one group for this reason.

#### **Will children sit at a desk on their own?**

Yes. Children will not share desks at any time.

#### **Do you have timed toilet trips like other schools have?**

Yes. Play and lunch times are staggered and only one child is allowed into the toilets at any one time.

#### **Are you staggering any play outside?**

Yes. Play and lunch times are staggered

#### **Can you confirm you are providing the free packed lunch if my child normally has hot meals? And if so, can you tell me what will be provided?**

Yes. A free meal is provided for all children in Reception, Year One and Year Two. There will be no hot meals.

The packed meal will most likely consist of:

- Filled sandwich or roll
- A fruit portion, box of raisins or crudités
- A portion of dairy – yoghurt or cheese portion
- A home baked dessert e.g. biscuit or cake
- A calypso-style drink

#### **Will there be any staff in PPE?**

No.

The DfE guidance states that PPE is unnecessary unless a case of COVID-19 is suspected in which case it will be worn by the member of staff supervising the child with symptoms until a parent comes to collect him/her.

#### **How will you provide first aid to a child that requires it?**

The administering of first aid is going to be more difficult than normal. It is our hope that with staggered breaks and much smaller groups we will encounter very few accidents.

Children will be encouraged to clean their injuries themselves as much as possible but we do have PPE available if it is needed for this purpose.

**Will I receive any information about how my child is getting on in these circumstances e.g. by email or Tapestry?**

Tapestry for Reception children will not continue because not all children are attending school.

An annual report will be coming home to you at the end of the academic year.

**For drop offs and pick-ups can I bring a younger sibling along?**

Yes. But only on foot, not by car.

**Can Key Worker children still arrive at 8:30am?**

Yes. Your child will go into their correct 'bubble'/classroom and will be supervised until learning begins with the rest of their group.

**What if I have changed my mind and I no longer want my child to return on June 1st?**

That's fine. We will call in the same way we always would on Monday morning and you can tell us you have changed your mind.
